REGIONAL SCIENCE FAIR JUDGING CRITERIA

The regional science fair award is designed to reward those students whose Science fair project is exceptional in quality and is of such a nature that it investigates a topic related to the fields of safety and/or training. In order to properly judge these projects in an objective manner the following guidelines should be used.

- A maximum of **four projects** are authorized to be awarded in each region each year.
- Projects may have more than one student participate in the project.
- It is **not required** that four projects be awarded if the project quality is poor.
- Projects must be related to Safety and/or training.
